- Determine what types of technology an individual might need
- Teach individuals how to use tools like screen readers, magnification devices, braille displays, and phone or tablet apps
- Change or adjust technology to best meet the needs for individuals at school, work, or home
- Stay current on programs and products
- Recommend strategies for digital inclusion and accessibility
- Collaborate with teachers, rehabilitation professionals, employers, and families to use technology effectively in various settings
